**UCRC to Hold 313<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting on Sept. 17**

*Agenda includes Upper Basin conservation efforts and updates on post-2026 operation negotiations*

**SALT LAKE CITY— Sept. 17, 2025 —** The Upper Colorado River Commission (UCRC) will hold its 313<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting on Wednesday, Sept. 17, from 9–10 a.m. MT. Agenda items include updates on conservation projects underway in all four Upper Basin states, discussion and an overview of the Commission's perspective on Basin States negotiations and the approach to post-2026 Colorado River operations.

The agenda reflects the Upper Basin's focus on supply-driven solutions, where water users already live within the hydrologic limits of the River, facing real, mandatory, verifiable and uncompensated shortages with economic and community impacts across the region.
