

## **Utah Diversion Measurement and Telemetry Program (UDMT) Eligibility Requirements**

Projects that are eligible for funding through the UDMT program must meet the following criteria:

- Project is located in the Utah portion of the Upper Colorado River System
- Project measures source diversions, return flows, and/or reservoir elevation and outflow (not lateral or mainstem)
- Reservoir elevation is only eligible if there is existing bathymetry information or an elevation-area-capacity curve is available.
- Applicant has a valid water right and the authority to participate
- Applicant will allow installation of real-time measurement equipment
- Applicant agrees to allow data to be publicly available and reported to the Division of Water Rights
- Applicant will allow and facilitate site access
- Applicant accepts a flexible installation window (typically outside of irrigation season)
- Applicant agrees to all environmental and regulatory compliance
- Applicant has reviewed the implementation agreement included with this application and is willing to execute a substantially similar agreement if Applicant's project is selected.
- Applicant agrees to own/maintain equipment past the project period as set forth in the implementation agreement
- Applicant will comply with all applicable federal regulations and has read and is willing to accept the regulations referenced in the implementation agreement.
- Applicant agrees to allow UCRC, to share the contents of this application in its entirety with its contractor, Jones and DeMille Engineering, and the Colorado River Authority of Utah, and to share as much of the application that is necessary to obtain approvals that may be needed from the Utah Division of Water Rights and the US Bureau of Reclamation.
